MOISTURE MITIGATION

One of the things we have been working on for a while now is a moisture barrier that can be applied at lower temperatures. I am happy to announce that we have completed testing which has determined that Dry Coat Pro can be applied down to 38°.

This does however come with some extra things to be aware of.

1. The cure times at lower temperatures will be unpredictable. Be ready to aggressively sand or lightly grind the cured product before applying the next coat.
2. The cured product is likely to change colors or have a blushed appearance at lower temps. This does not affect adhesion or moisture mitigation properties.
3. Temps must remain above minimum of 38° for entire cure process. Failure to cure can occur at lower temps.

We have been and continue to work on a fast cold weather formula and expect that to be available before winter. The last component is to fix mix ratios. It currently must be mixed as full 3 gallon kit.
